Supply List

For the wrapped bowls:

Sewing machine with a zig zag foot, #80 or #90 needles to go through the clothesline, Cutting mat, rotary cutter, ruler, scissors, straight pins, $\frac{3}{4}$ yard fabric for a small to medium bowl (batiks look great), 30 yds of 3/16" poly reinforced cotton clothesline, thread to match fabric (same in bobbin), Iron and pressing surface. (Jean can you bring your pressing pad)

For the dolls: scissors and any interesting yarn.
